Hollywood Hills Elementary is a K-5 school in Broward County servicing approximately 771 students in Hollywood, Florida. The community we are located in is a mainly suburban, middle-class neighborhood. We have been rated an "A" school for 14 school years and scored a "B" for the past 3 school years. The community of Hollywood Hills has seen quite a bit of growth over the last three years. Memorial Regional Hospital and Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital, directly down the street from our school, has experienced major expansions including construction of a four story children's hospital.

Our school has a diverse student population, faculty, and staff that adequately represent the population of our community. Our student body population is as follows: 38.5% white, 11.9% African American, 3% multi, 1% Asian. Forty-five percent of our student body is Hispanic. We have steadily increased to almost 50% of our student population receiving free and reduced lunch. There are 109 ELL students, 118 SWD students, and 47 gifted students at our school, which enable us to offer a gifted/high achieving class at all grade levels except kindergarten. Our faculty and staff is composed of 70% white, 20% Hispanic, and 10% African American which closely reflect our student population. The staff is comprised of teachers and faculty that reside in Hollywood and surrounding communities. This enables many of our teachers and faculty to be a working part of their community, thus building relationships with parents, students, and businesses alike. Most recently our faculty has incurred some major changes. Our faculty and staff is committed to our students and their success in all areas, socially and academically.

The goal at Hollywood Hills Elementary, along with its stakeholders, is to provide a challenging curriculum that will allow students to develop in all areas. By incorporating technology and authentically engaging work based on high standards for our students, we are preparing our students to be college and career ready adults in the 21st century. Elementary works together with parents, students, community members, and teachers to provide the level of support that is necessary for students. This partnership is crucial in raising student achievement and providing all that is needed for students to be able to work to their fullest potential.

Hollywood Hills Elementary provides its students with a rigorous curriculum that is engaging and diverse. Our D3/D4/D5 program offered in 3rd - 5th grade allows students to access their education through the use of personal laptops and utilizing unique programs expanding learning opportunities in ways traditional methods do not. These technology enhances 21st Century learning to the classroom that is both engaging and mentally stimulating. Currently teachers are trained in CANVAS, which is the platform that the teachers and student use for the Digital program. The program is fully implemented and uses the gradual release model for instruction.

Hollywood Hills Elementary's goal is that all students master the state standards in all subject areas. Our curriculum for core subject areas is carefully selected by the county. We supplement the curriculum in order to meet the needs of all our students, providing interventions and enrichment programs and lessons that best meets the needs of the individual student.

The practices and program offerings at Hollywood Hills Elementary support our mission and beliefs. Differentiated instruction based on formative and summative assessments are analyzed in grade level data teams to plan for instruction. Each grade level meets for weekly professional learning communities where teachers can plan their instruction based on a C.A.R.E. cycle using performance tasks to evaluate student mastery on each of the Florida Standards. All teachers have been trained in Core Connections writing which focuses on text based writing across the content areas. Hollywood Hills Elementary continuously uses data to reflect and make informed decisions to increase student achievement.

Hollywood Hills Elementary believes that a strong parent-school connection is crucial to the success of each student.

Parents receive weekly parent links with important class and school information. The school website and PTA website also offer a wealth of information for parents to stay connected. The school initiates a variety of activities, programs and events throughout the year to ensure that parents have an opportunity to become actively involved in the school. Some of the many school-wide activities include parent/teacher conferences, Character Parade, Book Fairs, Family Fun Nights, Honor Roll Assemblies, Reading Across Broward Award Recognition Assemblies, Curriculum Night, Showcase of Success, School Drama Performance, PTA meetings and events, Technology Q & A sessions and more.

Over the last three years, Hollywood Hills Elementary has made many notable achievements. In addition to the numerous achievements Hollywood Hills has accomplished, the school has also secured funding of several grants. These grants include the Achieving Excellence in Education City of Hollywood, Broward Education Foundation, and Target Grant. These grants have been utilized in several areas of the school.

Hollywood Hills Elementary has also raised funds for Honor Flights for Veterans to travel to Washington D. C. to honor American Veterans for their sacrifice so that they may visit memorials. Community service projects include: Recycling Program within the school, collections of books for new mothers at Memorial Regional Hospital, Earth Day tree planting, Harvest Food Drive to benefit needy families.

Additionally, areas of improvement that Hollywood Hills Elementary is working on are Response to Intervention (RtI) to more effectively monitor struggling students. The RtI program has been fine-tuned and the monitoring process has been structured to insure that all students are receiving individualized and remedial instruction, when needed. Student progress is also tracked very closely using the DATA Chat model, with each individual teacher. These chats have provided opportunities for teacher self-reflection, student data analysis and additional information that is incorporated into our weekly Professional Learning Communities. As a result, Hollywood Hills Elementary has increased effective individualized instruction and has in turn raised student's mastery scores on grade-wide assessments.
