The students and staff demographics are a representative of the community at large. The student population, which is a similar correlation to the community has 71% of students on the free and reduced lunch program, and has 5% of students that are English Language Learners. We have quite a few unique features and challenges that are associated with the clientele our school serves. One of our biggest challenges is although our school is based in the City of Plantation, we provide education to more students from the City of Sunrise and City of Lauderhill. This situation tends to make it more challenging for students to travel quickly back and forth from school resulting in students not being able to travel to nearby events the school hosts as easily or get home later in the evening due to transportation. However, Plantation High School makes every opportunity available to help our students overcome the challenges and provides several opportunities to help students succeed at the school regardless of their situation.
