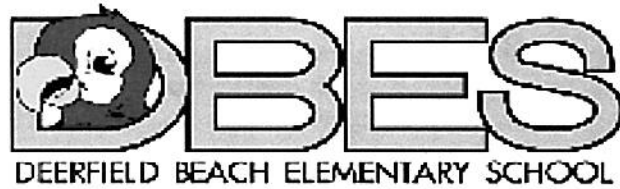

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- I. Welcome .....Mr. Gerlach**

Safety Update – “hard corners” is new policy update for safety. Each classroom will have a “hard corner”; bathrooms are the hard corners for most of our classrooms. School Board is working with each area/school to see who will oversee projects/contract to create “hard corners”.  
Other policy – anyone on campus can call in for a lockdown of codes. Every code posted in each classroom and updated policy list (new verbiage). Parent had questions about volunteers on campus if there was a code for all staff, volunteers, and subs. All will take a course/training to know/understand what to do for next year.

- II. Data Update..... Mr. Gerlach**  
Schoolcity still used for data but tweak a little this year. Instructional Cycles still in placed then test then to remediate and/or enrich. As a school, data that was pulled in January, we were projected from averages of schoolcity & BSA, last year we missed a “C” by 15pts. Missed in the area of the lowest quartile from making gains. 316 points out of 46% gains in lowest quartile for ELA and 51% for math. 38% in ELA for grades 3-5. 43 students that are within a range to score a level 3, they just need a few more points. Last year – we provided extra push in but the problem was that we never changed the kids around. Second weakness – we only focused on overall comprehension. So this year we shifted and

did an item analysis for every standard in reading. It is about 15-20 standards then break it down by kids and what they need. We are projected for a C as this point. We would like to get to a B or very close to it. We then followed up with a Q & A. One parent asked what other tools are we using to progress monitor students. Mr. Gerlach answered formative assessments and the BAS. Another parent asked what do we plan to do next year to build from this? Mr. Gerlach answered that we will use our student EOY data to determine our next steps while also pulling in qualitative teacher data through responses.

**III. School Update/Important dates..... Mr. Gerlach**  
Kindergarten Round Up – March 20<sup>th</sup>. Cooper & Gerlach will be visited each daycare to hand out flyers and introduced themselves to help get our name out there. Science Night will be postponed, new date will be in April. Will updated with parent link and newsletter once booked. May 15<sup>th</sup> is our Art/Music Night; maybe combine SAC/PTA meeting to get more involved for parents.

**IV. SMART Bond updates.....Mr. Gerlach**  
Outside classroom almost done, concrete floor started today, outside garden gate (white fence) – completed. Also, classroom furniture was updated, small group tables were first and a must. Also new carpets for primary and bookshelves and/or easels. Last piece to purchase is updating chairs (student chairs). Outside classroom will be a novelty approach for the rest of this year. Next year, make a schedule to create more opportunity for classes. Working with PTA for next year for ideas to use the outside classroom more effectively. There is another smart bond initiative coming up. Redoing media center as well as our AC vacs. Next meeting PTA/SAC meeting maybe have someone present ideas for new media center and to get parents involved in decisions.

Title 1 Parent Training Meeting is tomorrow at Horizon Elementary School at 7pm. Flyers went home a few weeks ago.
