- I. Welcome .....Mr. Gerlach**  
Mr. Gerlach introduced members and city members as well as Smart bond instructors who presented the information for our smart bond update.
  
- II. School Improvement Plan 2019-2020..... Mr. Gerlach**  
Every school will be completing a “state” plan for the next school year. Each plan looks at different “groups” to categorize how students are performing. Similar to the plan that we completed this year by being a school grade of D. The county and state will provide feedback on how to navigate each group for increase in data. One group that we are low on is African American students. We will create a goal/plan to help reach those students and aim goal with percentages. We will be looking at the data first to then brainstorm and collaborate to again meet the goals. Mr. Gerlach asked the parents for feedback on our school improvement plan for the 2019-2020 school year. Parents feedback – extended school day opportunities given to students in the media center to work on computer for example – iReady. Parent suggested maybe find more opportunities to give back to students in need that are in our school. Also, another parent suggested a better mentorship program for all students. One parent mentioned the first grade

program that is used in one of our first grade teacher's classrooms. Other suggestions – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade parents, more homework (one page a night now but would like more) as well as with better communication & feedback from teacher to parents. Parent is considered that work is lower than expected and wants more rigor. Another issue/suggestion would be translation for out school/school event. Struggle is though that our teachers are not “leaving” in a good way that don't match the school population. But there are programs that can be used to help bridge the gap with the issue. Would also like more communication with parent to teacher and vice versa. Have more flyers (school based) in translation. Grade level “conference days” which was highly recommended, Kindergarten piloted this year so we can hoping to make it school wide next year.

**III. School Important dates..... Mr. Gerlach & Ms. Soeder**  
Bylaws 2019-2020

Bylaws were reviewed from this year to then look at the bylaws for next year (2019-2020). Bylaws include the purpose of school advisory council and the memberships that are needed for our committee. All agreed on bylaws and can amend in September's meeting.

2019-2020 Committee for SAC

Positions – more parent representatives than staff members, SAF chairperson, multiple different parent representation. A listed of SAC positions are posted on our website.

**IV. eProve Survey Results 2018-2019.....Ms. Soeder**

We had 64 parents complete the surveys. We had a lot of good feedback – we had 99% at strongly agree or agree at our school has high expectations for students in all classes. Also, 99% at strongly agree or agree that our school communicate about its goals and activities. One thing to work on to increase – my child has access to various types of school counselors based on his/her identified needs” about 20% was either neutral and disagree. Overall, pleased with the results and hoping for a continuation next year with an increase of parent responses.

- V. **SmartBond Update.....Ms. Boyer & Mr. Schiappa**  
 Denise Williams also in attendance as well.  
 Updated status on the smart bond project. This presentation is to convey any concerns and project updates in each phase. Once there is a contractor hired then we will move into the next phase which would be the actual improvements being implemented. Then we come back to discuss more and get another update meeting. At this time, the timeline of the phases has it completing in Quarter 4 of 2020 for roughly 5 million dollars. Updates include but not limited to, building improvement, media center renovations, HVAC improvements, general repair to building 1, fire alarms updates in all buildings and then sprinkler system in building 1. School choice enhancement program – music and technology has been completed, outdoor classroom started but continuing.
- VI. **Title One Update.....Ms. Soeder**  
 Last Parent Training is on May 16<sup>th</sup>. It is a free event and all families that attend will receive a game. Translators will be available if needed. It is at Colbert Elementary in Hollywood and the event is from 7:00-8:30pm.
- VII. **SAF.....Mr. Gerlach**  
 SAF Representative for 2019-2020  
 School Advisory Forum: Parent representative with meetings a month. Meetings are at Monarch High or Coconut Creek High. Need a parent that interested, if please let Ms. Soeder know.
- VIII. **2019-2020 SPBP (School Positive Behavior Plan).....Dr. Cooper**  
 The school wide expectations – have self-control (how can we see that in data), be respectful, be cooperative. Proud parrot coins in cafeteria once a class collects 10 coins then class is rewarded (ice pops). PTA provided the ice pops and pizza when classes earn 40 coins. Implementing the positive behavior program has decreased our number of referrals in multiple of areas. Less referrals on the bus and on the playground. Students enjoy the program and the accomplishments they see from their actions. PTA provides

funds for lunch coins and P-squared. Looking for maybe sponsors for each month for rewards. Parents were given time to give feedback and if any questions with the 2019-2020. All agreed on the behavior plan, some suggestions were to posted classes that receive rewards on website or Tweet out so parents can recognize as well.
