SAC Minutes - December 12th @ 2:05 p.m.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Dania Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on December 12th 2018 @ 2:05 pm.

Mr. Ricketts called the meeting to order. Ms. Danielle will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Review of Minutes - Read by Jean Ellis Motion to accept Danielle - Seconded by Amanda Mizell.

Old Business:

Dr. Jackson reminds everyone can give input, but SAC decides and creates the proposals.

Mr. Ricketts read the potential proposals offered from the previous meeting, and submitted by staff.

Options are 1.

80/15/5, 2. 75/20/5 and 3. 93/7.

Dr Jackson explains SAC offers 2 options with none of the above option as the third. He also explained pro-rates for part time staff.

Ms. Danielle suggests another proposal of 4. 60/30/10.

Ms. Harmer asks for clarification on the language, and Dr. Jackson explains.

2:35 - SAC Committee vote is held to choose proposals. Options 3 and 4 are chosen.

2:40 - Verbiage is discussed to clarify proposals to make them clear.

Ms. Harmer suggests including non-returning staff that had 100+ days the prior year.

Consensus decides to use only returning staff.

3:00 - Proposals are crafted with proper language and titles.

3:15 - Verbiage is confirmed.

Mr. Ricketts read over the chosen proposals and the crafted language.

Option #1:

93% of allocated Recognition funds will be evenly divided between all instructional and non instructional staff who were employed during the 2017-18 School Year and returned to Dania Elementary School for the 2018-19 School Year. This includes Interim Substitutes and all personnel who worked more than 100 days last year. Any personnel whose percentage is less than 100% will be calculated according to the rate of the percentage they worked at Dania Elementary School.

The remaining 7% of the funds will be given to the school.

Option #2:

60% of allocated Recognition funds will be evenly divided between all instructional staff who were employed during the 2017-18 school year, who worked at least 100 days, and are presently employed at Dania Elementary School, including Teachers, Administrators, Autism Coaches, Literacy Coach, ESE Specialist, School Counselor, Speech Language Pathologists, and Support Facilitators. This will be prorated at their percent of employment last year and length of time that they were employed at Dania Elementary School.

30% of allocated Recognition funds will be evenly divided between all non-instructional staff who worked at least 100 days during last year including Clerical, Cafeteria, Educational Support Professionals, and Facility Personnel. This will be prorated at their percent of employment last year at Dania Elementary School.

The remaining 10% of the funds will be given to the school.

Option #3:
