Thinking of implementing ELOP, a program where our teachers are going to provide camps to our students after school, for a fee. Only teachers can provide the clubs, and we are still in the process of deciding clubs. Focused on enrichment outside of grade level skills. Fees will be \$10 - \$17.50 per class, and run 8 - 10 classes, with different sessions available. About 1 hour long. Parents discussed prices and parent availability.
