### NOTES

- Mr. Ricketts called the meeting to order and read the minutes. They were motioned to be accepted by Ms. Fishkin and 2nded by Ms. DeLease.
- **Title 1 Report** - Ms. Schwartz - Title 1 Report:  
Parents, community, and staff were informed that can now access the draft of the School Improvement Plan (SIP), along with the Title 1 Plan (Addendum) on our school website. - Mr. Ricketts further explained, "What is the SIP?" The School Improvement Plan (SIP) is a set of goals, objectives and action steps, which drives our educational activities relating to school improvement and education accountability. Parents, teachers, and administrators all have a role in developing these goals. Each plan shall address issues relative to budget, training, instructional materials, technology, staffing, student support services, specific school safety and discipline strategies, and other matters of resource allocation, as determined by district school board policy, and shall be based on an analysis of student achievement and other school performance data.
- Dr. Jackson: I-Zone meeting Friday - all parents invited, contact him if interested. Discussed Energy Conservation Program. Will start discussing Aftercare and looking at other providers if interested. Smart Money Meeting - will get project manager out to discuss at the next meeting. A+ Recognition Money...
  - Proposals for A+ money was discussed
  - 1st from Ms. Podesta recommended 75% for all who have remained 20% for all non-instructional and 5% for the school, also her second proposal was 80%, 15%, and 5%. Ms. Schwartz proposed making the proposal's more specific so that we don't exclude any of our current staff members. Ms Schwartz also recommended 90% to all staff members and 10% to the school. After more discussion, it was decided to leave it proposals open for one more week. They can be emailed directly to Mr. Ricketts.

- Ms. Markovich discussed the Food Recovery Programs and that we have received a grant for a commercial refrigerator. Exploring more options for fundraising such as hat days, sports and pajama days.
