- \* Mr. Taylor was recognized among District teachers for his integration of CANVAS.
- \* Thank you to PTO for coordinating the Annual Walk-A-Thon, scheduled for Friday, February 22, 2019.

Safety and Security

- \* The Safe Team conducted the annual Safe Team Meeting on Wednesday, October 4th, in conjunction with Broward County Public Schools' Special Investigative Unit (SIU).
- \* We reviewed safety scenarios and how to properly prepare in response to any given safety threat.
- \* All staff participated in a Safe Meeting on October 17th.
- \* We will continue to conduct Code Red/Yellow and fire drills on a monthly basis.

- \* Our Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan (SPBP) is being reviewed and revised, as needed.
- \* The revised SPBP will be shared with all stakeholders and voted on by staff by April 2019.
- \* All community members were encouraged to attend the District's Town Hall Meeting on School Safety on Monday, February 25th, starting at 6:30 PM at J.P. Taravella High School.

#### Academic Accomplishments

- \* All 3rd through 5th grade students have a laptop, providing them with one-to-one access and opportunities to acquire 21st Century Skills.
- \* All 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students are participating in the District's Benchmark Standards Assessment through January 25th.
- \* The students' results will be analyzed and used to inform and plan instruction.
- \* Title I Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) and ESOL's Language Enrichment Camp (LEC) tutorial sessions will begin the week of January 28th.

#### Student Enrollment, Staffing & Class Sizes

- \* K-5 = 534 students; Pre-K = 35 students
- \* We are 100 percent staffed and welcome 4 new staff members.
- \* All classes meet class size requirements.

#### General Obligation (SMART) Bond – Passed November 4, 2014

- \* The Safety, Music & Art, Athletics, Renovations, and Technology (SMART) referendum will provide \$800 million dollars to Broward County Schools over the next five years.
- \* Riverland Elementary School will receive \$1.95 million for in-progress and planned projects.
- \* Riverland Elementary School is presently working to spend the \$100,000 available through School Choice Enhancement Program portion of the SMART Bond.
