School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes February 28 - March 14, 2019 Cafeteria @ 5:30 pm

I. Welcome

The SAC meeting was called to order by Mr. Myers at 5:37 PM.

II. Approval of December's SAC minutes

The SAC minutes were reviewed for correction and grammatical errors. No corrections were made. Ms. Casson made the motion to approve the minutes reflecting no additional errors. Mr. Casson seconded the approval of the December meeting minutes. All SAC members were in favor to approve the December minutes at 5:41 PM.

III. Math Goal – Mr. Myers

All iReady data for math has been treading in a positive track. The interventions for students who are struggling are showing to be effective. Gains in math were made when comparing the first iReady Diagnostic and second Diagnostic. The final iReady Diagnostic is in April prior to the FSA. Grades 3-5th are approaching the end of their Go Math books. Parents, please continue to work with your child at home, especially with their math fluency.

IV. SAC - Title 1

We are recruiting people for SAC positions next year, if you're interested in being a representatives of SAC, please come speak to Mrs. Clinch, Ms. Zelaya or Mr. Myers.

We have our Literacy and STEAM family night coming up. There will also be a Curriculum night. Please provide suggestions of any other night you would like to

see next year. This year, we did incorporate performances as part of monthly family nights. We incorporated a Social Emotional Night which was suggested last year.

Mr. Norman received a petition requesting privacy screens along Pines Blvd and 64th Avenue. Unfortunately, the committee cannot approve the request for privacy screens. From a law enforcement perspective, it is important to be able to see through the fence for safety reasons. Mr. Norman came by on several occasions to assess the fenced area. Based on his observation, he didn't feel the students faced any safety concerns. The teachers did a great job to keep students away from the fence. Mr. Norman will get together with the Department of Transportation regarding cars speeding off the Turnpike Exit Ramp. He will keep Mrs. Clinch posted regarding that particular safety concern.

V. Principal's Report

This month is fire safety. It is suggested that families need to discuss designated meeting areas in the event of a fire evacuation. There also needs to be two evacuation routes in the event of a fire.

VI. Other Business

A parent had a concern about fire drills. As a parent, she is happy how her child is aware of the procedures and colors of the drills, however, sometime this can develop some anxiety. Mrs. Clinch said she will address this concern with the Support Staff at the school.
