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School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes April 25, 2019 Cafeteria @ 5:30 pm

I. Welcome

The SAC meeting was called to order by Ms. Zelaya at 6:23 PM.

II. Approval of SAC minutes

The SAC minutes were reviewed. Mr. Myers made the motion to approve the minutes. Ms. Zelaya seconded the approval of the March minutes. All SAC members were in favor to approve the March minutes at 6:25 PM.

III. Behavior Plan – Ms. Zelaya

We are in the process of creating our Behavior Plan for the upcoming school year. We will vote on it during our faculty meeting. As of now, we will continue with our R.O.A.R motto (Respect, Optimistic, Accountable, Resilient). We will conduct our Social Emotional Plan based on our motto. Parental input is recommended as we consider our plan for next year. Next year's plan will primarily focus on the dismissal process, cafeteria, and hallway behavioral procedures.

IV. SAC Committee – Ms. Zelaya

There are open SAC positions for next year that need to be filled (parent representative, SAC Chairperson or Designee, Gifted Representative, ESE Representative, ESOL Representative and PreK Representative). If you have any questions regarding the open position, please contact Mr. Myers or Ms. Zelaya. We meet once a month. Meetings are always connected to one of our family nights.

V. Title 1 Budget – Ms. Palacios

We were able to purchase iReady for next year. We also had money to purchase the iReady LAFS and MAFS workbooks for $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$. The students will be able to write on it.

Based on the current iReady Diagnostic, 3rd grade improved 20 points in reading proficiency and 5th grade improved 24 points. Next week, we have FSA and Science 2.0. The results will be in during the summer around June 30th, except for 3rd grade which will be May 31st. Other means of promotional criteria for 4th and 5th will be used since the results are in late. The criteria is 70% for reading and 60% for math and BAS level based on their grade level.

The order for Reflex Math was placed this week. We will use the program for K-5 next year.

We were approached by 7-11 to promote our game room as part of our Positive Behavior Plan. They will provide \$711 to fund our plan.

VI. Principal's Report – Mrs. Palacios

Tuesday during arrival, a student reported to a teacher that someone brought an inappropriate object to school. The school went completely into a Code Red. Ms. Palacios and Ms. Clinch called the police to rely on their expertise. The authorities were extremely prompt and professional as they conducted their investigation. The teachers followed every single protocol during the Code Red process. Staff members and students transitioned successfully into their regular day after the Code Red.

VII. Other Business

A parent was concerned about the law that may pass, regarding teachers being armed at school. Ms. Palacios said that is something that needs to go through the board. Currently, weapons are not allowed on school grounds including school parking lots. Ms. Casson stated based on the last Security Town Hall meeting arming teachers is not supported by Broward County Schools.

VIII. Adjournment

Ms. Zelaya made the motion to adjourn the SAC meeting at 7:02 PM on April 25, 2019. Mr. Myers seconded the motion. The next meeting is scheduled for May.
