 - b. Principal MR. THOMAS-->RECAP. HURRICANE→DEATH OF Former Student→STONEMAN DOUGLAS. FROM INTERNATIONAL SUMMIT (JAN 25-FEB 2)→200 GUESTS; MANY ROLES FOR STUDENTS; NEED MORE HOST FAMILIES - HAVING A SECOND OR THIRD LANGUAGE IS A POWERFUL SKILL AND MAKES ONE MORE COMPETITIVE→CLOSING SCHOOL→BUDGET FINISHED - MAY BE DIFFERENT THAN PREVIOUS YEARS→HIRING OF NEW SECURITY→DISTRICT CAME OUT TO WORK ON THE FENCING - SINGLE ENTRY FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR →SUPER-TESTING WEEK IS HAPPENING. MOST SENIORS ARE OFF, BUT AP TESTING IN FULL SWING.
 - c. BTU ELECTION HOPE – VOTE TO SUPPORT EDUCATION→MRS HILL AND MR. HENDERSON REELECTED AS STEWARDS
 - d. Student Government SENIOR PICS→SENIORS WANT THEIR GROUP PICTURE IN THE YEAR BOOK→AC NEEDS FIXED. (PARENT CONCERNS→ ARE THE ISSUES WE DISCUSS BEING FIXED – ANSWER: SOME ISSUES ARE FIXED BUT THINGS LIKE AC GET FIXED BY DISTRICT ONLY ON THEIR TIME SCHEDULE; QUESTION - IS THERE A RISK MANGEMENT RISK (PARENT ISSUE) RESPONSE: AGAIN DISTRICT CONCERN
 - e. School Advisory Forum (APRIL 11TH MEETING, ROBIN BARTELMAN SCHOOL BOARD REP SBBC VOTED THAT NO TEACHERS WILL BE ARMED; MIDWEEK START AUGUST 15; SUBCOMMITTEE CREATED BY DAC REPORTED THAT MANY SCHOOLS DO NOT HAVE CALENDERS ON THEIR WEBSITES NOR A CANVAS; APRIL 19TH - ADRIANA ERMOLI DIRECTOR OF GRANT WRITING STATED THAT 56 MILLION DOLLARS IS AVAILABLE IN FEDERAL FUNDING EACH YEAR AND 75% GETS LEFT ON THE TABLE; PTSA WILL HOLD A GRANT WRITING WORKSHOP AT PBHS ON MAY 21ST; ALL SCHOOLS ARE REQUIRED THAT ALL STUDENTS HAVE EQUITABLE SERVICES; ALL SCHOOLS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN EQUITY PLAN; GOVERNING BODIES MAY BE ABLE TO TAKE OVER A SCHOOL THAT IS NOT WORKING
