- I. Call to Order at 5:32 p.m.
- II. Reports
 - a. School Advisory Chair
 - i. Approval of Minutes (motions Lorber, Carter)
 - ii. Account Balances ($\$5847 + 408 = 6255$ Less Planners of $\$1946 = \4309)
 - b. School Improvement Plan Monitoring
 - i. SBBC SIP Plan
Plan Complete and OSPA seems satisfied; Best Practice #2 – Response to Intervention (RtI) – starts 9th with PASL (Personalization for Academic Socio-Emotional Learning); Eligibility Review (ER) – 2.5 Unweighted GPA; mentors are fabulous, student success at school and elsewhere.
 - ii. Accreditation Self-Assessment Monitoring
Standard 2 – Governance and Leadership – handbooks for students and staff- codes of conduct; staff positions for compliance; code of ethics and responsibilities for staff; school improvement plan, stakeholder input, agendas and minutes for meetings.
 - c. Principal – after break three weeks before exams, first quarter ends, day off on 1/7 – teacher planning – students return on a Tuesday; Moved a few years ago from regular and honors to all honors courses, applying now to College Board for Pre-AP program, cost is \$4-5K? with funding through testing, Courses - English, Biology, Algebra 1, Geometry, Human Geography will start in Fall, Natural flow into AP courses, 9th grade only first year, Competition is Cambridge but AP fits more with our school, Question of whether courses are on 5 or 6 point GPA scale, courses challenging and align to FSA and standards; International Summit – PTSA helping with supplies and donations, need sponsors, donation site on PBHS website; Per Ms. Spencer and Officer Smith -Vaping still an issue, training coming, security has new rules for teachers and students; Student comments and joking is no joke – be mindful of what you say – See Hear Say is working – parents need to check posts for threats, hate messages.
 - d. BTU – Election Process complete; Negotiations for this year and next will begin again
 - e. Student Government – Harvest Drive ended with success; 200 families picked up bags of food; Smashathon coming in December to aid Hurricane victims in N. Florida

 - a. A/B Schedule Vote Recap – 57/61 voted, 100% approve, 4 absent - passed
 - b. A+ Funds Ballot Vote – SAC to approve ballot, vote on November 28, need 66 2/3%; Ballot choice – 1. 100% to all, 2. 90% to all and 5% school expense, 5% summit, 3. none of the above. Motion to accept ballot with amended 3, not 2 pool subs (Angelakos, Lusskin)
 - c. Planners (2019-2020) - \$1946 through Mr. Williams; Motion to accept (Taylor, Carter)
 - d. New Waivers – None for this year; Mr. Henderson suggested committee consider if school needs change and advise at next meeting to research for next year.
