October 10, 2018

Meeting was called to order @ 5:30 pm by Samantha Brown, SAC Co-Chair.

-Samantha Brown reviewed the agenda.

-Principal's report covered the following items: PSAT testing for grades 9-11 was held on October 10, 2018.
