Stranahan High School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes October 10, 2018

Meeting was called to order @ 5:30 pm by Samantha Brown, SAC Co-Chair.

- -Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all
- -Samantha Brown reviewed the agenda.
- -Principal's report covered the following items: PSAT testing for grades 9-11 was held on October 10, 2018. SMART BOND updates include the completed pool, cafeteria renovations are discussions (the contract and architect has been hired). Building 5 is currently under construction. The facilities community meeting will be held every other month.
- -Teacher kudos to Mr. Vega. South Florida CW interviewed him as one of south Florida's super teachers.
- -Mrs. Sanon reviewed SAC composition and positions held/titles. Mrs. Sanon also discussed the SAC needs assessment and its completion.
- -Parents suggested using email blasts to inform parents and encourage consistent interaction, communication, and fundraising. Text message blasts as another means of communication was mentioned as well as starting a FACEBOOK.
- -Stranahan High School Twitter account is active, and the school's website allows for 24/7 access to school information.
- Technology is needed in the school to support learning and increase achievement .

- -Band building is in need of updates as well as new uniforms.
- -High school uniforms for all students were suggested by Ms. Miller to assist with dress code violations and set the tone for academic excellence. This motion was supported by Mrs. Langston to curb bullying/competition with students and alleviate financial stress on our parents.
