Croissant Park Elementary SAC minutes: 11/14/18

- Welcome and Introduction: Regina Steinbeck called the meeting to order at 7:30am
- Approval of Minutes: Ms. Laing mctioned to approve minutes from previous meeting held on 10/24/18. Ms. Leville seconded the motion. Mi nutes were passed. ASP provided donuts and coffee ©
- School Improvement Plan- FACE: (Family and Community Engagement) What have we done to show we are community school? (Fall Festival. Meth Night, STEM Night, Book Fair etc.) What have we done to show diversity of community and school? (Diversity Committee of Crusader Committee, participated in Hispanic Heritage Month, a 4th grade student in Ms. Laing's class represented our school at a diversity showcase) What have we done to show social emotional learnin g competency? (Ms. Dorlus has been rolling out SEL school wide, "Catch Them Being Good"- recognizing students/staff for going above and beyond) Principal's Report:
 - School data presentation: Ms. All son intends on discussing school grades at each meeting moving forward. 3 Year Data Trend- Reviewed 2016, 2017, 2018. Reviewed FLDOE grade, calculated grade and total point %. Reviewed ELA Achievement %, ELA Learning Gains %, ELA Gains Low 25%, Math Achievement %, Math Learning Goals %, Math low 25% goals, and Science Achievement %. Free and Reduced is 91%- SES bound of 2. (1-6). Bound 1 is 95%+. These bounds are categorized by the state. CPE has one of the highest number of ESOL students (270). To qualify for a full time ESOL coordinator at your school you need 300 students. Most schools have approximately 20-100 ESOL students. PreK/K students coming in low and also face a language barrier. Based on demographics- Ms. Allison feels we are doing well. We are one point away from a B (53). Ms. Allison will be looking at assessments with faculty with regards to what and how many. Staff will have to take all trainings necessary.
 - Security: The buzzer system has been approved. Contractors are coming out next week to survey the area and
 - Chorus continues to practice on Mondays and Wednesdays to prepare for December presentation. Kindergarten has been added to the show. STEM night is 11/14/18
