12th Grade English regulars are ready to embark on "Hamlet" and a research paper due by the end of the first semester. Components have been taught in previous grades and now is the time to put it all together.

11th Grade English is starting "The Tempest" along with various essays.

Both 11th and 12th are incorporating grammar instruction every class with remediation where needed. Grammar has been the academic stepchild since FCAT and is now beginning to play a larger role with SAT's using the EBRW (Evidende based reading and writing) as one of the concordant scores. (430 to replace FSA)

I. Math: We are continuing to make adjustments in our math classes. Although we've had shifts, we are able to continue working hard. Algebra I is now ending the Unit 2 and will start Unit 3 next week. Geometry has had a few hiccups due to testing, but we should be able to get back on track starting next week.

PERT will be given to our Seniors next week Wednesday, same day as PSAT.

YMCA math is still recruiting students. We're hoping more students will begin attending this week.
