#### Call to Order:

A meeting of the Blanche Ely High School Advisory Council was held in the Amphitheater February  $19^{\rm th}$ . Mr. D. King called the meeting to order at 6:43. Steven Woloszn will record minutes for this meeting.

#### Minutes:

SAC Meeting Minutes 2/19/19

- Mr. D. King called the meeting to order at 6:43. Members reviewed the meeting minutes from January. Ms. Robinson motioned to accept the minutes w/ the corrections as discussed (attendance). Ms. Walker seconded. A vote of Aye carried the minutes.
- The attendance will need to be changed to reflect those who attended and those who didn't. Mr. Woloszn will take care of this.
- Accreditation Self-Assessment: Mr. Spence referred to the list of AdvanceD Standards for Quality Schools. This is just a small representation of what these standards entail.
- > Mr. D. King asked about standard 2, Governance and Leadership. Mr. Spence shared that this concerns how the school is led. There are several indicators involved in this. Mr. D. King would like a copy of this standard. Mr. Spence will share.
- > Ms. D. Robinson asked when SAC will be working on next year's School Improvement Plan. Mr. Spence said that this will take place either in March or April.
- He also updated the group on the SIP. Most areas of business have been uploaded to the FL Department of Education.
- > People can go to the FL DOE website to see the SIP.
- > There are conversations going on with data. Dr. Johnson is meeting w/ teachers for the next few weeks.
- ➤ Ms. Wade-Lester asked if the SIP is on the school's web site. Mr. Spence shared that it will be put on the site. 2017-18 should be on the site now. He will check w/ the webmaster to make sure. Mr. D. King stated that he just checked the web site and noticed that the 2017-18 SIP is not there.
- Ms. Wade-Lester wants the SIP available for community members to check. She checked other schools and saw that they do have their SIPs on their web sites.

- > Ms. Walker also expressed the need for the SIP to be on the web site.
- > Mr. Spence will make sure that the SIP does get put on the site.
- > Ms. Fields asked if other departments will be having data chats. Mr. Spence shared that Dr. Clark is in charge. He also said that data drives instruction.
- New Business: Ms. D. Robinson asked about the update on the tutorials that are occurring. Things that were said to be done aren't in place. For example, the selection of teachers wasn't put out for teachers to volunteer for.
- > Mr. Spence had informed Ms. Watson to keep the group posted on the program. However, she was not present at this meeting to update the group. Mr. Spence will make sure that Ms. Watson is present at the next SAC meeting to give an update.
- Several members expressed concern about this process.
- > Ms. Wade-Lester would like to have the minutes shared w/ the county so that they know where the accountability. The process concerning the tutoring program needs to be followed.
- Ms. N. Blands also expressed a concern that the process needs to be followed. The county needs to be made aware, and perhaps needs to put a freeze on the funds. There needs to be accountability.
- The details from the minutes were looked back at. The issue of using remaining funds left over from the \$5000 will be used to purchase paper and supplies will need to be stricken from January's minutes.
- > Mr. Spence informed the group that he will bring the selection of the tutoring teachers to the next day's leadership team meeting.
- > Mr. D. King shared that the county's web site has other school's SIP posted, but Blanche Ely doesn't. Mr. Spence shared that he updates the web site quarterly. Mr. D. King shared that this should be done every 30 days.
- > Ms. Wade-Lester wanted it documented that the leadership of this school is not making sure what SAC wanted done (tutoring) is being done.
- ▶ Mr. D. King asked about the mid-year school reflection is being done. Mr. Spence shared that it has been done. He will have a copy of the document for the next meeting. He will also make sure various documents are posted on the school's web site in a more timely manner.
- > Ms. D. Robinson wished the group a happy Black History Month. Some teachers participated in the door decorating contest. There will be a wax museum in the Media Center this coming Friday and the following Monday.
- > Mr. Spence commended Ms. D. Robinson and Ms. C. McGirt for their work promoting Black History Month on campus. We want to make sure the kids are proud of what's happening here.
- > Ms. Wade-Lester asked that the school begins working on these areas earlier in the year.

- > Mr. Spence shared that Ms. L. Holloway spearheaded a Greek potluck luncheon. He also asked Ms. D. Robinson to share just what is happening for this month.
- > The Eta Nu Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. are coming in next week as part of the Black History Month programs on campus.
- > The Divine Nine are the 4 sorority and 5 fraternity predominantly black Greek organizations. They began basically because of exclusion from white sororities and fraternities. Only two of them began outside of Howard University. Their focus is social change within our communities.
- > Ms. L. Fields asked about the situation w/ the patio area. Mr. Spence shared that the architect is working on additional visual representation of what the patio renovation will entail. Dr. Johnson has asked that charging stations be incorporated into the renovation.
- > Mr. Spence will bring the new visuals to the next meeting so members can see them.
- Ms. Blands asked about the target completion date for the patio. Mr. Spence shared that Thanksgiving of this year is the date. The small gym should be completed by the end of this month.

The next meeting will be held on March 19th in the Amphitheater.

Ms. Walker motioned to adjourn at 7:39. Mr. Blue seconded. The motion carried unanimously with an Aye.


