

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:46 p.m. in the performing arts conference room by co-chairperson Jeanie Jones.

Roll call/Sign In

The group was instructed to sign-in on the proper form.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed, and the following corrections were made, to add Bridgette Brihm and Juliana Bruce to the attendance. Under principal's update change "them" to "themselves." In the last sentence the next meeting date should read January 16, 2019. A motion was made by Ms. Robinson and seconded by Martina Barfield to accept the minutes with the corrections. The motion passed.

UPDATES

Principal's Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson asked the group to introduce themselves. Mrs. Robinson stated 100 of our Dillard students and 10 chaperones were treated to a performance of "Hamilton" at the Broward Performing Arts Center. A scholarship recruitment fair was held yesterday on campus at Dillard. Representatives from an array of HBCU's were able to offer students on the spot scholarships. Aiyana, Alonzo, and Bridgette shared their offers. ID's are still required each day. Saturday School begins in two weeks, lunch will be provided. All after school activities will be canceled on February 14 and 15 in honor/memory of the MSD tragedy. Students in need of replacement ID's should see Ms. Matthews, the cost is \$5. The district is seeking/identifying safe spaces in classrooms. Students who find themselves off campus during a code can seek a safe haven at nearby McDonald's or Dunkin Donuts, *are establishments they can go to.*

School Improvement Plan Update

The mid-year reflections are coming up.

Title I Update – Dr. Paul

Dr. Paul informed the group of the Title I Parent Seminar taking place at the Signature Grand. The Parent and Family Engagement Survey is taking place. A Title I parent workshop will take place January 29 in the recital hall. The mobile unit will be here to tour and will have materials for elementary aged students.

New Business

Announcements

-Mr. McLean stated the Marching Band will be participating in the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr Parade. The "Festival of Winds" will take place January 23 with our concert bands. He informed us that this is assessment time for all of the bands. He also shared 18 of 25 Dillard students are represented in the All-County Jazz Band. The concert takes place January 30. Three Dillard students made the All-State Honors band in jazz, 2 students in concert band for the entire state of Florida. Summer Camargo attended the Next Generation Band.

-Ms. Adams informed us of the upcoming events for the cheerleaders.

-Ms. Garcia representing the Sigma-Catz, thanked SAC for the help and support we have given in the past. Raphael and Dylan shared experiences they have had working on the robotics team. They brought refreshments to share with the group.

-Aiyana and Alonzo informed us Sankofa will host a documentary and panel discussion honoring Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. on January 24, 7:00 – 9:00 pm.

-Mrs. Robinson stated Dillard is one of two schools named a Five Star School. The other school receiving this distinction is Cypress Bay. One component of the selection is to have an active SAC.

-Alonzo stated Senior Brunch tickets are still available for \$50 (PG-19 – Not Yet Rated).

-Jassamyn Joseph shared SGA activities. Each day SGA has a black history trivia question for students to answer with their teacher. They are also planning activities for "Take Your Child to Work" day.


-January 31 and February 1 are the dates for the annual Solo Dance Show, 7:30 p.m. in the Black Box.
