

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:44 p.m. in the performing arts conference room by co-chairperson Teralyn Butler-Overstreet

Roll call/Sign In

The group was instructed to sign-in on the proper form.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed and the following corrections were made, delete Bridgette Brihm from the attendance and add Jassamayn Joseph. Under principal's report restate "McDonald's and Dunkin Donuts are nearby establishments..." and change Bridgette to Jassamayn. A motion was made by Mr. Hodge and seconded by Jassamayn Joseph to accept the minutes with the needed corrections. The motion passed.

UPDATES

Principal's Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson asked the group to introduce themselves. Dillard students delivered the colors and sang "Lift Every Voice and Sing," at the recent school board meeting. In honor of last year's tragedy at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High, Dillard did a 17 + 1. The plus 1 was for the student Dillard lost in 2008, Amanda Collette. The jazz band has once again been invited back to the Essentially Ellington jazz competition. The theater department will be presenting "The Merry Wives of Windsor" this weekend. "Shades of Blue" gospel extravaganza will take place Sunday, February 24. Our winning girls basketball team will be going to state. Ms. Butler-Overstreet shared the wonderful opportunity our Academy of Finance has. A team of 4 came out and reviewed the program. We will find on May 15 whether we made it.

Title I Update – Dr. Paul

Dr. Paul shared upcoming deadlines for Title I. The Parent and Family Engagement Plan was mentioned. Results from the parent survey will be shared within the next couple of months. Stemfest will be held March 9, 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. for parents and students at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport. Dr. Paul is considering having the Title I meetings on the same night as SAC.

School Improvement – Dr. Smith

Dr. Smith shared our mid-year reflection. Students are taking common assessments in reading/english and math. PSAT, ACT, and SAT practices are taking place. Data is reviewed bi-weekly. Teachers are participating in professional development

Unfinished Business – None

New Business

Lily, O’Shawn, Raphael, and Dylan from the SigmaC@t Robotics Team made a great presentation to the group sharing the history as well as the current progress of the team. The students, along with their teacher mentor, Mr. Szoke, and parent mentor, Ms. Garcia are seeking \$4000 to help offset the cost of taking students to the Palmetto Regional in Myrtle Beach, SC. They have a sponsor who will match the amount SAC is able to give. A motion was made by Mrs. Robinson and seconded by Ms. Giannini to give them the \$4000 they are seeking. The motion passed. The event will be streamed on March 1st at BlueAlliance.com.

Mr. Israel Charles, Artistic Director, spoke on behalf of Mr. Christopher Dorsey, Director of Jazz Studies. The jazz band is seeking \$12,000 to help offset the cost of their trip to New York City to defend their first place title at the Essentially Ellington Jazz Festival. For the second year in a row, Dillard has the winner of the composition award in Miles Lennox. A motion was made by Mrs. Robinson and seconded by Mr. Hodge to give them the amount requested. The motion passed. Mr. Charles thanked the group and stated what they do is not normal.

Announcements

Ms. Jackson shared events from the music department. On February 21 the Wind Orchestra will be collaborating here on campus with Dreyfoos School of Music from Palm Beach. February 22, the Symphonic Band will be participating in the Wind Festival at Florida Atlantic University (FAU). February 23, the Marching Band will be participating in the Sistrunk Historical Festival Parade and the Fort Lauderdale Pride Parade. Last week both jazz bands received straight superiors. This past weekend, students participating in solo and ensembles received superiors, with only one excellent. Mrs. Robinson stated that is why the school’s theme is “Together We Make Great Things Happen.” Ms. Butler-Overstreet state at the Business Professionals conference (BPA), 16 students became eligible to compete at the national level. One student, Asharia Holtzclaw, (from Ms. Bell’s kindergarten class) became our first student to hold a mid-level office.

A motion was made by Mr. Hodge and seconded by Dr. Smith to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p.m. The motion passed.
