ESSA – Every Student Success Act (ESSA) has replaced No Child Left Behind. ELL subgroup and students with disabilities fell below the 41% mark. Individual plans will be made for these subgroups. We will receive more information in June that will go into the 2019-20 plan.

Allison Hankerson-Harris addressed the group about school safety. She told the group about “lock down” kits that would be used to address students’ restroom needs during lock downs. She stated Dillard could possibly be a pilot school. Mrs. Robinson explained what is presently in place at Dillard.
