

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:41 p.m. in the Performing Arts conference room by co-chairperson Jeanie Jones.

Roll call/Sign In

Ms. Jones directed the group to sign-in on the proper form.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed, and the following corrections were made, change "Arlizza" to Arliza, add Ross to the name Mary, take out the number nine in the word "children". A motion was made by Jassamayn and seconded by Ms. Jackson to accept the minutes with the corrections. The motion passed.

UPDATES

Principal's Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson reminded the group that special testing days effect the entire student body. Both high school and middle school students are released early on those days. The top 10% breakfast will be held tomorrow. Tomorrow night is senior awards night. The final dance performance will be held this weekend. Prom will take place May 25th. Pre-prom begins at 3:00. Graduation takes place May 31st. The Jazz Band came in second place at the Essentially Ellington Jazz Festival. Ms. Beharrie will be taking a group of students to perform at Carnegie Hall this summer. Dillard is now a Cambridge High School. Joseph William, project manager, summarized the construction and school improvements that will be taking place. The items included, buildings 3-10 will be reroofed, buildings 7-10 will have improvements to the HVAC units, electrical improvements to buildings 7,8,9, and 12, fire sprinklers placed in the gym.

Title I Update – Dr. Paul

Dr. Paul solicited parent input on the use of parent involvement funds. The amount from the previous year was \$699. After a brief discussion it was decided to continue to use the funds for refreshments. Dr. Paul thanked the group for their help, attendance and involvement.

School Improvement Plan Update – Dr. Smith

Dr. Smith shared with the group that teachers will continue next year with 8 professional study days next year to collaborate.

SAC Officers-Elections

We did not have a quorum to complete officer elections. Elections will be tabled until the 2019-20 school year. Meeting dates for next year were discussed. Dr. Smith asked the group if the dates and times were working for us. She asked that we consider possibly moving meetings to a week earlier, because often there are reports due later in the month. We will prepare to vote in the fall.

Announcements

Ms. Jackson shared news from the band. A "Senior Symposium" was held, topics included College Readiness, Drug Health and Welfare, a meal also was provided. The Wind Orchestra received straight superiors all year. Sound Check gym battle takes place, Friday, May 24th. Advance tickets are \$10, tickets are \$15 at the door. The band banquet will be held May 29 at the

Urban League. One of our students, Mahkyah Ray received her own personal trombone from All-County Music, in honor of student Alex Schachtner who was lost in the Stoneman Douglas tragedy. Ms. A. Smith gave us additional information on the Cambridge program. She stated this was our first year. ACE will make our students globally competitive. We tested 90 students, 8 in digital media. The application was written for 6-12. Dr. Paul gave us information regarding the upcoming Title I Parent Training Academy taking place at Colbert Elementary, "Avoiding Summer Learning Loss." The final Dance Concert and Senior Showcase takes place May 18 and 19 in the Main Theater. Ms. Bell thanked the seniors present for their participation. Mrs. Robinson wished the group a great summer.

Adjournment

A motion was made by Ms. Forrester and seconded by Ms. A. Smith to adjourn the meeting at 6;20 p.m. The motion passed.

The next meeting will be held in the fall of 2019.
