

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:36 p.m. in the performing arts conference room by co-chairperson Jeanie Jones

Roll call/Sign In

The group was instructed to sign-in.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed, and the following corrections were made, under New Business add Martha Adams – SAF Chair, under Announcements Mrs. Adams reminded us to place SAC and SAF meeting dates, minutes, and agendas on the website. A motion was made by Mrs. Adams and seconded by Mr. McFadden to accept the minutes with the corrections. The motion passed.

UPDATES

Principal's Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson stated Homecoming was a huge success. We are into the third day of Tech Week. Mr. Larry Farrow came out and spoke to the students. Our school received \$655,000 in Title I funds \$300,000 was placed into Technology. Math and ELA assessments have taken place. Ms. Forrester asked if this was the same money that was taken from the budget. Mrs. Robinson stated yes, and that even though she managed not to cut staff, there are restrictions for the use of the funds coming in this time of year. Soul Bowl will take place November 3 and will include tailgating. Parent's Night Chat and Chew will take place this evening. The Dillard Jazz Ensemble will be presenting "The History of Jazz" in the auditorium this evening. Mrs. Robinson asked that we pass along to staff that once again no food deliveries. The single point of entry (one-gate) was discussed. Mrs. Robinson stated that she knows the heightened security is uncomfortable. Whenever a gate is open, a person must be there.

Title I Update – Dr. Paul

Dr. Paul stated the Title I addendum is almost complete, as well as the Title I e-binder. Free and reduced lunch forms are located on-line. Students need to have their parents complete the forms to help the school keep its funding. We discussed having a school-wide campaign to encourage families to complete the forms.
