Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:36 p.m. in the performing arts conference room by co-chairperson Jeanie Jones

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed, and the following corrections were made, under New Business add Martha Adams – SAF Chair, under Announcements Mrs. Adams reminded us to place SAC and SAF meeting dates, minutes, and agendas on the website. UPDATES

Principal's Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson stated Homecoming was a huge success. We are into the third day of Tech Week. Mr. Larry Farrow came out and spoke to the students. Our school received \$655,000 in Title I funds \$300,000 was placed into Technology. Math and ELA assessments have taken place.
