# Principal's Update - Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson asked the group to introduce themselves. Mrs. Robinson stated Soul Bowl was a huge success, tailgate was great. The varsity football team ended the season as district champions. The JV football team ended with an undefeated season. The cheerleaders won their first competition. Parents will begin to receive monthly phone calls when code yellow/red drills take place. Hall sweeps will take place one to two times per week. Students should wear their ID's daily. Saturday School and Saturday detentions have begun. Mrs. Robinson gave the floor to Ayanna Edwards, Student Government Association (SGA) President. Ayanna gave us information about the Sankofa program. Alonzo Frederic informed the group of senior class information. This is the last weekend of the theater departments show, "The Color Purple." Four hundred students from schools throughout Broward County attended a showing today. Mrs. Robinson will have her principal's reception at the final showing on Sunday and invited the group to attend. She asked that we each have a great, safe Thanksgiving.

#### **New Business**

DHS Cheerleaders - Ms. Pekia Burke

Mr. Ernest Merrell, Head Competition Cheer Coach, came in with a proposal asking the SAC committee to help the team reach their goal of competing at the Universal Cheerleading Association National Competition February 8-10, 2019 at the Disney Resort in Orlando, Florida. The team has reached the level of state champions in 2018,2017, and 2015. They have never competed at the national level. Mr. Merrell submitted 2 options for the group to review. Mrs. Butler-Overstreet provided the group with the "Request for SAC Funds Guidelines." After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Ms. Bell and seconded by Ms. Forrester to use the provision "…allowances may be made for documented extenuating circumstances" and grant the cheerleaders \$7,680 for their registration. The motion passed.

# PASL – Dr. Jacqueline Smith

Dr. Smith gave the group information about the Personalization for Academic and Social Learning (PASL) program and the 130 ninth-grade students it serves. She is seeking \$1,500 for incentives for the students they serve. A field day will be planned for later in the year. Ayanna asked if Student Government could assist.
