Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:36 p.m. in the performing arts conference room by co-chairperson Teralyn Butler-Overstreet.

The group was instructed to sign-in on the proper form.

UPDATES

Principal’s Update – Mrs. Robinson

Mrs. Robinson asked the group to introduce themselves. Mrs. Robinson stated Soul Bowl was a huge success, tailgate was great. The varsity football team ended the season as district champions. The JV football team ended with an undefeated season. The cheerleaders won their first competition. Parents will begin to receive monthly phone calls when code yellow/red drills take place. Hall sweeps will take place one to two times per week. Students should wear their ID’s daily. Saturday School and Saturday detentions have begun. Mrs. Robinson gave the floor to Ayanna Edwards, Student Government Association (SGA) President. Ayanna gave us information about the Sankofa program. Alonzo Frederic informed the group of senior class information. This is the last weekend of the theater departments show, “The Color Purple.” Four hundred students from schools throughout Broward County attended a showing today. Mrs. Robinson will have her principal’s reception at the final showing on Sunday and invited the group to attend. She asked that we each have a great, safe Thanksgiving.

Title I Update – Dr. Paul

Dr. Paul informed the group of the Title I activity taking place on November 28, 6:00 p, m,-dinner, 6:30 p.m. program, in the Black Box. Ms. A. Smith, Mr. Woodburn and other staff members will be involved. Parents will be given tools to help their children. Parents are encouraged to attend.

School Improvement Plan Update – Ms. A. Smith **Best Practices #4 -Goals, Strategies, and Activities**

Ms. A. Smith reviewed a component of the school improvement plan. She gave the group a very thorough presentation on best practices and strategies, and activities that are part of the plan. She also shared with the group targeted elements of the plan.

New Business

DHS Cheerleaders – Ms. Pekia Burke

Mr. Ernest Merrell, Head Competition Cheer Coach, came in with a proposal asking the SAC committee to help the team reach their goal of competing at the Universal Cheerleading Association National Competition February 8-10, 2019 at the Disney Resort in Orlando, Florida. The team has reached the level of state champions in 2018, 2017, and 2015. They have never competed at the national level. Mr. Merrell submitted 2 options for the group to review. Mrs. Butler-Overstreet provided the group with the “Request for SAC Funds Guidelines.” After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Ms. Bell and seconded by Ms. Forrester to use the provision “...allowances may be made for documented extenuating circumstances” and grant the cheerleaders \$7,680 for their registration. The motion passed.

PASL – Dr. Jacqueline Smith

Dr. Smith gave the group information about the Personalization for Academic and Social Learning (PASL) program and the 130 ninth-grade students it serves. She is seeking \$1,500 for incentives for the students they serve. A field day will be planned for later in the year. Ayanna asked if Student Government could assist. A motion was made by Ms. Jackson and seconded by Martina too grant Dr. Smith the funds. The motion passed.

Announcements

Ms. Forrester informed the group the Marching Band received straight superiors at their Marching Band Assessment.

Mr. McLean stated the Marching Band is headed for the Florida Classic and Battle of the Bands in Orlando, Florida.

Alonzo Frederic, class treasurer stated class packages are due January 11, 2019. The cost is \$380.

Martina invited the group to attend “Wacky Olympics” being held at McArthur High School, December 8.

Ms. Butler-Overstreet will be partnering with Leontyne Butler and Joel Robinson to host a Health and Wellness Fair which will focus on Alzheimer’s and other information.

On November 29, 7:00 p.m. the Dillard Center for the Arts Wind Orchestra under the direction of Sheldon A. McLean will host an evening of music.

A motion was made by Martina and seconded by Mrs. Robinson to adjourn at 6:38 p.m. The motion passed.
