Overview: The purpose of this meeting is to discuss important school related information.

Topics:

- iReady Data & SIP Data/Progress Monitoring
 - 2016 – C School with 42% of points
 - 2017 – C School with 45% of points
 - 2018 – D School with 39% of points
 - After looking at individualized student data based on iReady diagnostics 1 & 2 our predictions are:
 - ELA 40% +11
 - ELA Learning Gains 52% to 37% -15
 - ELA Lowest Quartile 46% to 39%
 - Math 38% to 44% proficiency
 - Math LG 40% to 32%
 - Science 29% to 40%
 - Staff must work with a sense of urgency to continue stretching students. Although this is a prediction based on our mid-year diagnostics, we plan to exceed these numbers through the continued implementation of high quality instruction infused with more resources and materials we have been waiting to receive this year. Acaletics will begin in the classroom very soon in Math and Science (for 5th). All students have received Ready LAFS and MAFS, as well as other supplemental ELA resources that cover science and social study topics.
- SAC By-Laws – we do not have quorum to adopt this year’s SAC By-Laws. We will address this again next month.
- 21st CCLC – We have had a successful kickoff to the 21st CCLC. We currently have 75 students enrolled. The students enjoyed their first day yesterday and we received many positive comments from parents.
