

Oakridge Elementary
School Advisory Council Minutes
February 6th, 2019

Overview: The purpose of this meeting is to discuss important school related information.

Welcome! Meeting called to order by Mrs. Pendlebury at 7:36am.

Topics:

- SIP Updates
 - Mr. Aguilar will be presenting to Cadre directors and Mr. Runcie the schools background and data. We will also have a SIM visit on February 13th. Mr. Aguilar shared his presentation with the SAC attendees. He highlighted some changes that have been implemented since his arrival at OES (administration and support staff changes, introduction of VPK to OES). Mr. Aguilar highlighted some barriers we encounter. The current action plan for Oakridge – a growing VPK program, LLI support, Data Chats, MTSS/Rtl weekly, PLC's 3x a month for each grade level, BAS progress monitoring, iReady Reading/Math monitoring, Acaletics, ELL/ESE best practices, development of the Elementary Literacy Department.
- Anti-Bullying
 - Flacco is partnering with OES to promote anti-bullying. Flacco is teaching students a no-contact anti-bullying boxing exercise class. This is a 4 week program available on Fridays with 1 Saturday meeting at his Community Gym. The cost is \$15 per 4 weeks.
- SAC By-Laws
 - Article 3 – Section 3: Length of Term: Members of the SAC shall be elected for [one, two, or three]. Miss Moore made a motion to select one. All members present are in favor.
 - Article 4 – Section 1: Officers of this commit will consist of [a Chairperson, Co-Chairpersons]. Mrs. Rafuls made a motion for a Chairperson. All members present are in favor.
 - Article 4 – Section 2: The officers shall be elected annually at the [August, September, October, November, April, or May] meeting. Mrs. Muhammed made a motion for August. All members present are in favor.
 - Article 4 – Section 3: Installation of new officers will be held at the [First or Second] meeting of the school. Miss Moore made a motion for the First meeting. All members present are in favor.
- CANVAS – We are looking at how teachers are using CANVAS in the classroom and how we can expand that, especially in the older grades.

- Behavior
 - The numbers of referrals received have almost tripled since first quarter. Most of these referrals are from students that are frequent behavior concerns. Many of the referrals are submitted for these students as a form of tracking for Rtl. The data is used to create behavior plans with incentives. Team Leaders will be reviewing the data a little deeper in today's Team Leader meeting to see if there are any areas for improvement as we begin planning for the 19-20 school year.
