**Administrative Report –Mr. Bonnie Clemon, Jr., Principal**

**\*Stakeholders Surveys**

- The Stakeholders survey gives an opportunity for staff, students and parents to give their input about the school. This is done annually every school year.
- Students and staff have completed the number of surveys to reach compliance. Only 44 parents have filled out the surveys.
- The deadline for completion has been extended to April 30, 2019.

**School-wide Positive Behavior Plan**

The faculty voted 100 percent to accept the Behavior Plan.

- The plan will be submitted to the District and enforced through the 2019/2020 school year.
- Students will be expected to comply with the rules of student conduct, wear I.D. badges, exemplify positive behavior and be respectful to faculty and staff and be responsible for being to class on time. The Behavior Plan is posted in three locations on campus: *Cafeteria, Room 127 and the Main Hallway.*

**Continuation Waiver:**

The waiver is good for five years but must be voted on annually. The faculty voted in favor of continuing with the Professional Study Day Waiver. The five tentative dates for early dismissal of students are:
