## SAF Agenda @ 8:30 a.m.

- Welcome- The meeting was called to order at 8:45 by Mrs. Bailey. She welcomed parents and guests and turned the meeting over to Ms. Kassim, who welcomed Ms. Shanlene Brown to bring SAF updates.
- Updates- Ms. Shanlene Brown attended the CAA along with Mrs. Maxine Brivitte. She spoke of the concerns brought up at the meeting which included safety and security, vape pens, and dual enrollment. Information presented informed parents that the District was possibly looking into doing random metal detector checks of students in high schools. Parents were concerned that students would be targeted and that searches would not be random. Parents were urged to check their child's backpacks to make sure they were not bringing weapons to schools. The parents responded by stating that all schools should be equipped with metal detectors that students must walk through before entering campus. The District is also looking to reduce the amount of Code Red drills that schools are required to perform because some parents complain that the mental stress it places on students is too much. Ms. Brown informed parents that a good portion of the meeting focused on vape pens. She warned that the pens go undetected because they are small, can look like USB ports, smell like candy/fruit flavors, and are colorful. Finally, Ms. Brown reported out that the district would be reducing the amount of college courses offered to high school students because many students are not or are barely passing the courses.
