## II. A+ School Recognition Funds/Ballot Generation

- Created to provide financial award to schools that improve a letter grade. (3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row!)
- Today we must create a ballot for teachers and staff to vote.
- Last year 90% of the funds went to all instructional and non-instructional staff who worked 100 days or more. 10% of the funds went back to the school.
- Ms. Robinson suggested that all funds be evenly distributed to all staff members.
- Ms. Robinson suggest we use option 1- 90% of the funds went to all instructional and non-instructional staff who worked 100 days or more. 10% of the funds went back to the school. Nurse Steele seconds motion.
- Menneke suggest option 2- 85% of the funds went to all instructional and non-instructional staff who worked 100 days or more. 15% of the funds went back to the school. Nurse Steele seconds motion.
- Ms. Wiggins suggest option 3- 80% of the funds went to all instructional and non-instructional staff who worked 100 days or more. 20% of the funds went back to the school. Mrs. Rodriquez seconds motion.

o 85% to staff 4 votes yes; 15% to school 4 votes no

- o 80% to staff 2 votes yes; 20% to staff 6 votes no
- Final results for options
  - Option 1: 85% to staff 15% to school
  - Option 2: 90% to staff 10% to school
- Voting to modify both options to add staff present 100 days or less if ONLY on a school board approved maternity leave.
  - Votes for yes- 8
  - O Votes for no- 0
