### September 13, 2018

- Meeting called to order at 2:15 by Mrs. Stephens
- Minutes from previous meeting in May 2018 reviewed and approved by Mrs. Green and second by Mrs. Witt

#### Administration Report

- Mrs. Frost provided a handout about 2018 FSA scores and how they are calculated by the state. Bayview made an A and made improvement from 2017 FSA scores!
  - -Grades 3-5 are tested in ELA and Math
- -Learning gains were made and the lowest 25 percentile also made gains We showed improvement in the categories (7) that calculate our score.
- -Our enrollment is 580 students. We've have worked diligently with the demographics department and the re-registration process to ensure students are enrolled where they need to be.
  - -We have 56 staff members. Class sizes are averaging 20 students(K-5).
- Blended learning is in full swing. Students have access to I-Ready and this program provides remediation/instruction/enrichment for our students. Diagnostic testing for this program is underway and is 86% complete. Thank you PTA for providing this new tool in reading and math!
- Mrs. Frost has applied to Cambridge International. Ft. Lauderdale High school uses this program and hopefully along with Sunrise Middle School Bayview will be able to use this method of instruction. The application is in!
  - -Playground is being built! Yeah! The playground will be K-5.
- -A Fort Lauderdale police officer is here daily from 7:30-3:00. This may change to the guardian program, but for now we have an officer each day.
- -Staff checks campus daily for security procedures. Our visitors to campus have been very compliant with the new procedures.
- -Safe Haven International has been out to our campus. They are the company contracted by the district to make suggestions to the board to make our BCPS safer. They came this summer and walked the campus with Mrs. Frost and Mr. Ellis. This was phase one. In

phase 2 the company will watch a typical school day on our campus and then write a report. In phase 3 they will interview staff about safety and safety procedures.

-Fencing is being put around our campus to make us more secure. The video surveillance system has been updated and can be viewed by administration and the district. Question? Is a buzzer system for opening the office door to be installed? Mrs. Frost says it has been discussed, but the cost makes it unfeasable for now.

## Florida School Recognition Program Governing Legislation

# Governing Legislation: <u>Section 1008.36</u>, Florida Statutes

**Summary of Provisions** 

The School Recognition Program recognizes the high quality of many of Florida's public schools. As authorized in <u>Section 1008.36</u>, the program provides greater autonomy and financial awards to schools that demonstrate sustained or significantly improved student performance. Schools eligible for school recognition demonstrated exemplary improvement by one of the following

- Receiving a school grade of "A;" or
- Improving at least one letter grade over the previous year; or
- Improving more than one letter grade and sustaining the improvement the following school year;
- Schools designated as alternative or ESE center schools that receive a school improvement rating of "Commendable" or improve at least one level are also eligible for school recognition.

Up to \$100 per Full-Time Equivalent student shall be awarded to each qualifying school by the Commissioner of Education.

The staff and school advisory council at each recognized school jointly decide how to use the financial award. As specified in statute, schools must use their awards for one or any combination of the following:

- Nonrecurring faculty and staff bonuses;
- Nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials; or
- Temporary personnel to assist in maintaining or improving student performance.

If school staff and the school advisory council cannot reach agreement by **February 1**, the awards must be equally distributed to all classroom teachers currently teaching in the school. If a school selected to receive a school recognition award is no longer in existence at the time the award is

#### Timeline of A+ Money/ School Recognition Program

- SAC creates written proposals in the form of a ballot.
- The ballot must contain 2-3 options: 1-2 from SAC and 1 option of "None of the Above"
- Ballot will then be presented and posted for staff 3 days before the vote.
- All staff members will silently/anonymously vote for one choice.
- The option with the majority vote will be implemented.
- (majority vote means one more than half the staff)
- If no option receives a majority, SAC meets again and comes up with new proposals and the process begins again.
- This process can repeat until February 1<sup>st</sup> at which point the award will be equally
  distributed to all classroom teachers currently teaching in the school.

## 2017/2018 Recognition Funds - Ballot

- A. Funds to be divided equally between all 2017/2018 instructional and non-instructional Bayview employees. Amount will be based on employee's job status, part time/full time. Employee MUST have been employed for the complete (school) calendar year.
- B. Funds to be divided 60/40 (Instructional/Non-Instructional), 2017/2018 employees. Amount will be based on employee's job status, part time/full time. Employee MUST have been employed for the complete (school) calendar year.
- C. None of the Above.

## 2018/2019 Recognition Funds - Ballot

- A. 100% of the funds to be divided between all 2017/2018 instructional and non-instructional Bayview employees. Amount will be based on employee's job status, part time/full time. Employee MUST have been employed for 100 school days.
- B. 90% of the funds to be divided between all 2017/2018 instructional and non-instructional Bayview employees. Amount will be based on employee's job status, part time/full time. Employee MUST have been employed for 100 school days. Remaining 10% to go back to the school for educational equipment and materials.
- C. None of the Above.
