- I. Roll Call
  - a. The meeting was called to order at 2:25 PM by Ms. Valliere, SAC Chair.
- II. Approval of Minutes from January 2019 meeting.
  - a. A motion to approve the minutes was initiated by Mr. Fletcher and Mrs. Frazier seconded the motion.
- III. Principal Updates
  - a. Ms. Coachman-Williams presented the school updates.
    - i. I-Ready goals have been in the process of being developed by the student's and achievement of the goals will be rewarded. Student's will be meeting with their teachers to discuss how to meet their goal's and why they may not be at this time.
- IV. Comments and Concerns
