  - Message from Administration
    - SAC funds for 8<sup>th</sup> grade incentives
      - \$6219 requested for:
        - ◆ \$876 Certificates for 8<sup>th</sup> grade award ceremony at Lauderdale Performing Arts Center
        - ◆ \$1200 for Lauderdale Performing Arts Center
        - ◆ \$4132.50 T-shirts for students end of year trip (443 students)

  - Curriculum Presentation- Performing Arts
    - Passed out flyer from PA open house
    - Only PA magnet school in Broward county
    - The PA program prides themselves with the Rigor in the program. They Perform and compete nationally.
    - Dates of performances are on website. Next year performances will be on Thursdays.
    - There are no afterschool clubs in PA due to the high amounts of competitions and performance preparation.
    - PA students can pick up a minor program, with exceptions in Theater.
    - Beginning courses are offered for non-magnet students.

- ❖ Title 1 Information
  - Review of Title 1 2018-2019 Parent Survey Results
    - Only about 10 of the 200 surveys were returned. Results were discussed; an increase in family communication and reminders needs to take place for next year.
    - Surveys were distributed targeting ESE and ELL families and were given in multiple languages.
    - As a school we will be using the parent stakeholder surveys in addition to the Title 1 survey in order to make a plan to best serve our school.
  - Title 1 Allocation
    - Discussion on how Title 1 funds will be allocated was started and suggestions were taken. Final discussion on Title 1 allocation will take place in our next SAC meeting.
  - Parent and Family Engagement Plan
    - Based on our Review and discussion of the outcomes of 2018-19 parent engagement plan the 2019-2020 plan was established.
    - The 2019-2020 Parent and Family Engagement Plan was distributed and reviewed by all in attendance.
    - Time was allotted for suggestions.
    - Suggestions: add more ESPN nights, and add a middle school expectations night, add communication about classroom technology and websites into our open house.
