1. Meeting commenced at 9:05 a.m.

Goldie Fenster – SAC Chair

- Motion to approve minutes from April 3rd – Motion: Ms. Sheri Watson Second: Ms. Laura Zatkowsky
- Hoping to continue to with the members of our SAC committee.
- Welcome new guest: Ms. Melanie Wever.
- We will hold off on setting the first meeting dates for next year until the first meeting next year.

2. Budget update

- a. Accountability Balance: \$18,808.00

(Mr. Anderson mentioned that he is able to allow these funds to roll over since he is able to fund things through other budgets.)

Every school got \$100,000 to spend

Awning didn't work out

Playground – company gave us a very good price, but the company wasn't submitting the proper drawings and is trying to comply. Bliss was the original quote, but it was extremely high. It has small short slides, and is \$35,000.

We have a quote with a cover and the District has asked that we get two separate quotes.

Ms. Charlotte Kramer

- Would like a bigger more elaborate playground

Mr. Anderson

- How many people feel that we should spend \$10,000 and get a bigger playground. Unanimous vote to get a bigger playground.
- Anderson – Should we go with the cover? Unanimously Agree
- We would have to take down the cover if there is a hurricane.
- We have to come up with a menu of the price value and give parents a choice. Parents have to vote on it. We can start with the playground over the summer when we don't have kids on campus. A ballot will be put together, and it will be shared with the school community to vote.

Ms. Lisa Alvarez – what happened to the fifth grade hallway?

Mr. Anderson – a quote was never sent.

- Same as with Egan’s hallway... they wanted \$14,000 to remove the island. We are addressing it with the Safety Department.
- Keeping laser printers
- TCC bathroom retiling – waiting on quotes

10. 2018 – 2019 Elections – no changes from the current slate. Ms. Goldie Fenster will be the SAC Chair and Ms. Lisa Alvarez will be the Co-chair. Ms. Maria Fialkov will be our secretary again. All were in favor to keep our Chair and Co-chair.

11. Administrative Update

- Broward Schools Before and After School conducted a Quality Needs Assessment with 29 indicators. Tropical received 4.0 on every indicator except for 3 of them where we got 3.5 points. We received a 98.7% overall score.
