Data Collection – Survey Results from 2018

- Survey Results from 2018 shared with everyone. Parents overall rating 4.5, Staff overall rating 4.2, Student Overall Rating 2.8.
- Results shared from each of the five areas rated (Purpose & Direction, Governance & Leadership, Teaching & Assessing for Learning, Resources and Support Systems, and Using Results for Continuous Improvement.
- Areas in which we scored the lowest were Teaching and Assessing for Learning and Resources and Support Systems

Data Collection – Test Results from 2018

- School Level Strategic Plan shows student performance in math as 31 percent in 2016, 35 percent in 2017, 38 percent in 2018. Goal for the 2019 school year is 45.9 percent proficient.
- School Level Strategic Plan shows student performance in reading as 25 percent in 2016, 28 percent in 2017, 32 percent in 2018. The goal for the 2019 school year is 35.9 percent.
