#### Call to Order:

A meeting of the Broadview Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center on Thursday February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Ms. Knight called the meeting to order at 2:40 p.m. Rocio Morell recorded minutes for this meeting.

- Report: we've analyzed all our BSA data and are happy with the results. We also just had our mid-year review with our Cadre director. For 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, we've dropped in reading and math. In 4<sup>th</sup> grade, we've gone 35.3% to 52.1% in reading and from 51.8% to 63.5% in math. In 5<sup>th</sup> grade, we've seen an increase from 30.5% to 44% in reading and from 40.9% to 40.6% in math. Our Cadre director explained to us, that all 3<sup>rd</sup> grade percentages across the district have dropped due to the change in the test which is not aligned to what the students learned in second grade last year. To help and support our students, especially in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, we have paraprofessional groups starting soon, we have Literacy Coach and Reading Interventionist pulling groups and our upcoming Saturday crunch time camp. Mr. White presented some questions on what supports would be given to 5<sup>th</sup> grade math. Ms. Morell and Ms. Hainlin explained the various support in our crunch time plan.
- Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO): Starting on Feb. 23 and will be every Saturday through the end of March, except for Spring Break. This will be for third through fifth grades. The day will be split half for reading and half for math. We also received the ESOL grant again this year. With that grant money, we will

- Ms. Knight reviewed Mid-Year Reflection for School Improvement and important days coming up.
- Ms. Britney Poitier presented her Equity Liaison and Community Liaison information.
  - On Feb. 14 is the one year anniversary of the tragedy that happened at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. We are hosting a Community Day of Peace here at Broadview. It will begin at 9 am and will end at 12pm. We will be revamping our butterfly garden, saying a Peace oath and putting up a Peace Pole. Through this we will become Wildlife Habitat Certified.
  - O Black history Night is also coming up. The evening of the 28<sup>th</sup> we will be hosting a night of choir singing, fashion show, and other fun events celebrating black history month.
  - o Through the equity plan, we have to now bring awareness to various groups of people (LGBTQ, Women History, Black History, Jewish/Holocaust history).
- PTO presented upcoming fundraisers. Mr. White discussed the upcoming cookie dough fundraiser.
