#### What is "No Child Left Behind"?

Education act signed into law in 2002 that aims to:

- Ensure that every student has a high-quality education
- Challenge and motivate students
- Provide highly qualified teachers, who use proven teaching methods
- Ensure a safe, drug free learning environment

### So Broadview is a Title 1 school; what is Title I anyways?

- Title I is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools designed to increase academic
- The goal of Title I is a higher quality of education for every child.
- The Dept. of Education distributes Title 1 funds to schools based on the number of low-income students (those eligible for free/reduced lunch) and then those who have an academic need

#### How Title I Works

- The federal government provides funding to states, then the state (Fl. Dept. of Education) sends them to the district which disperses them to the eligible
- Broadview creates and implements a School Wide program. Funds can be used to upgrade the educational program in ways that may impact every student in the school

### Parent's Rights

- Be involved and request regular meetings to expression your opinions, concerns and questions
- Be provided information on your child's level of achievement on assessments in reading/language arts, mathematics, and science;
- Request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teacher
- Be informed if your child is taught by a non-highly qualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks.

#### Title I funds

  - \$3,400 ASCD Conference
  - \$1,000 Afterschool Clubs
  - \$12,000 Teacher Stipend for FSA Camp
