April 17, 2019

Summary

- Welcome - Ms. Boyd welcomes everyone at 5:47pm, no quorum in place, the following is a brief summary of meeting.
- Appoint SAC Nominating Committee
 - During our previous SAC Meeting it was discussed that we need to form a committee to nominate a future committee. Parents vote for parents, teachers for teachers, community members for community members.
 - We may need to move the next meeting to the beginning of May due to deadlines. Information will be coming.
- School Improvement Plan
 - Accountability Funds- discussed Generation Genius for students K-5 (science), Go Noodle (physical fitness, brain breaks, stress reduction), and Nearpod, which now acquired Flocabulary for the next school year.
 - Ms. Boyd stated that she would be purchasing Story works for 4th-5th grade, Story Works Jr. for 2nd-3rd grades, and Scholastic News for Kindergarten and 1st grade from other school funds
- Turnaround Arts Information
 - Seussical was last month and everyone expressed their enjoyment of seeing the play and the impact on student behavior and attention to detail as reported by teachers.
 - Artists are coming out once a month for teachers in grades 1st through 5th. Artists are teaching spoken word, etc. ... focusing on standards
 - National Principle Summit- Six students were picked to meet & greet with principals from various areas.
 - 10 students go to Disney for an Arts Integration Training being done. May 31st Ms. Boyd will be going through essays and picking the students who will participate.
 - Beauty and the Beast - Being kind, don't judge a book by the cover etc. - Teachers will be given a range of SEL related themes to use for next year
- Title I
 - Parent survey was sent out through both copies and online on the school's website.
 - PFEP 2019-2020 Parent Family Engagement Plan copies were provided for parent to review & Title I spending,
 - 2019-2020 School Parent Compact
 - Flexible Parent Meeting – Discussed ways to get more parents involved. Suggested looking into having meetings on a Tuesday.
 - If there are suggestions please contact the front office by July 1st and we will address
- Schoolwide Behavior Plan
 - Data was reviewed for Positive Behavior Plan. 2017-18 total referrals for the year was 54. 2018-19 60 referrals as of the 3rd Qtr.
 - Students Positive Behaviors Plan for next year has been developed and staff needs to approve the plan during next staff meeting.
 - Teachers will be mandated to teach behavior lessons in August, and after Winter & Spring Break. Every teacher will be provided School Expectations. Disciplines referrals there were varying factors, extended school day, rules need to be reviewed, sub-teachers out, modified calendar, student's registered since Spring Break 15 students, Students will also have more frequent rewards and a quarterly- lunch with principal etc... Teachers are going to be given a guide line for referrals.
- Smart Bond Budget
 - With the money left over and new District requirements of all student required to wear a badge. We would like to vote on purchasing I.D. Badge makers for next year.
