

# Lake Forest Elementary School Advisory Committee (SAC) Meeting May 8, 2019 Minutes

## • Welcome

Ms. Boyd and Ms. Sparks-Lee welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming out to the meeting.

## • Review Summary of April Meeting

 We had previously met the requirement for our annual meetings, but we did not have a quorum in April to vote on programs from the accountability funds account. A summary from the previous meeting were provided to all to look over.

#### • School Improvement Plan

- O Accountability fund currently has \$11,434.06. The school would like to acquire license for Nearpod for teachers to use within the classroom. Nearpod acquired Flocabulary (included in the license) and we currently have 5 certified teachers. Committee voted and it was approved. Go Noodle, a licensed program that is used to provide brain breaks, indoor recess, breathing exercise. Cost \$1500.00 Committee voted and approved.
- Generation Geniuses was a program the 4<sup>th</sup> grade acquired this year. It provided curriculum, videos, assessments, exit tickets, and hand on activities. School wide site license \$495.00 Committee voted and approved the purchase of the program.
- The programs are provided for students in grades K-5. Purchasing these programs leaves \$4439.00 in Accountability funds.

# Smart Bond Budget

Remaining money left over and new district safety mandates requiring students to wear ID badges, proposed use of SMART money to purchase an I.D. Badge maker and extra supplies for next year. Approximate cost \$6000. Committee voted and approved.

## Assessments

- FSA results are expected to be in by 3<sup>rd</sup> gr May 31, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> June 30. This is latter than normal, and we will look for ways to send parents the information (ex. parent link, etc.)
- All students in grades 1<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> will be taking the Alternative Reading Assessment and 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will
  need to take an Alternative Math Assessment.
