Attendance:

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Floranada Elementary School Advisory Council held on April 4, 2019 in the media center. Co-Chair Ann Landley called the meeting to order at 5:16 p.m. Gina LaBarbera will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Mr. Nathan Cherson motioned to approve the minutes of March 7, 2019 and Mrs. Rebecca Taranto seconded. The minutes approved as is with no correction.

Old Business:

It was reiterated and confirmed by all members that the Parent Activity Funds be used for agendas and Publix Gift Cards, as was discussed at the last meeting. This is the same as the previous year.

New Business:

A member raised a question regarding the gifted classes. Mr. Vetter explained that it is mandatory to have a gifted class in 4th and 5th grade but not in grade 3. The plan for the new school year 2019-2020, is there will be no gifted class in 3rd grade since students labeled gifted is only a couple yearly. Instead, balancing the classes seems more realistic and any gifted students to be with a gifted teacher in the grade or serviced by another teacher. Also addressed was our volunteer of the year, Mrs. Leeta Hardin. Career Day is on May 21, 2019. This year, we are highlighting women who are instrumental in the community to come in and address the students.

Reports: Mr. Vetter [principal]

SAC discussed and voted on the School Wide Positive Behavior Plan for the 2019-2020 school year. Mr. Vetter explained that the plan is set up to review the data quarterly with focus on the top five behavior incidents. A suggestion made was to explain bullying to parents. It was further discussed that expectations will be taught through lesson plans and videos created by Mr. Vetter. The SAC committee unanimously approved the plan with editing made to Critical Element Area # 8.

Mr. Vetter reviewed the School Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan [PFEP] 2019-2020. Some activities on the plan changed to co-sponsor since SAC and PTA. coordinate them. Another change was to fifth grade activity. It will be termed "Moving up Ceremony" instead of graduation. SAC asked for parent input. Parents were included in the development, evaluation, and revision for the 2019-2020 School Level Parent Involvement and Family Engagement Plan. Finally, SAC members highlighted the fact that the Internet Safety Night was very informative though attendance was sparse. It was suggested to it would be even more beneficial if it could be tailored to elementary school.
