

Call to Order:
A meeting of the Cresthaven Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the <u>Media Center</u> on <u>4/18/19</u>
. Chair <u>Denise Camuto</u> called the meeting to order at <u>2:30 PM</u> . <u>Jessica Beckett</u> will record minutes

Minutes:
New Business:
Assistant Principal Heavner, welcomed attendees. Ms. Heavner presented the School wide Positive Behavior Plan for 2019-2020 and explained that it was developed by a committee of faculty members. Expectations were based on behavior incidents/referrals and lesson plans were developed to address those issues. She explained that the plan had been presented to staff who voted to accept it as written.
Ms. Heavner also reviewed the SIP goals and actions steps from this year 2018-2019. She suggested that the focus for next year 2019-2020 would continue to be ELA and recommended possible steps to increase proficiency. The steps focus on "Balanced Literacy" and include additional training of teachers in addition to continued support and instruction for guided reading and activities that meet the rigor of the standards taught. Ms. Heavner then opened the floor for parent suggestions / input into the SIP for 2019-2020. No suggestions were forthcoming.
Mrs. Camuto, SAC co-chair, went over the results of the Title I Parent survey. Overall, the school got highest ratings in communication though the rating for feeling welcome declined from the previous year. This is likely due to the new dismissal procedures put in place. Ms. Heavner explained that unfortunately the school must abide by district directives with regard to campus access but indicated that maybe more clear communication would help parents understand the intent.
Mrs. Camuto reviewed the Parent and Family engagement Plan. The floor was opened to receive input for allocation of parental involvement funds. No suggestions were forthcoming.
Mrs. Camuto reviewed the School-Parent Compact including language suggested at the last meeting regarding student behavior. She asked for any other input. No other questions or input were forthcoming.
