Call to Order:

A meeting of the Deerfield Beach Middle School, School Advisory Council was held in the <u>media center</u> on <u>9/26/2018</u>. Chair Rhoda Scott called the meeting to order at 3:37 <u>pm</u>. <u>Dr. Juanita Kearse-Creech</u> will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Introductions were made by each member present from the Deerfield Beach Middle staff and then the Deerfield Beach Middle parents and students. The SAC chair read School Advisory Council's purpose and the rules of how the meetings will be operated. Mrs. Livingston stated that we want to have transparency as to the roles of the parents and staff. Meetings will be held at an earlier time, commencing at 3:30pm the 3rd Wednesday of each month. The time was moved in an effort to get more parents involved since it is right after school.

Principal's Report: Dr. Fulton thanked each member for coming to provide details and feedback on how to improve student achievement. Dr. Fulton stated that he has an open-door policy.

We are 85 students over projection. Class size is over the state mandate. The school has been allocated additional funds to add three new teachers. The hiring process is going on currently. Today we completed a code yellow and code red drill. There were some issues that can and will be addressed quickly. We will continue to work with staff and students to make sure they know the proper procedures during these types of drills which will be held once monthly. Dr. Fulton gave thanks to Deputy Williams and the security team for all their hard work. The gate has been changed and is not closed all day. There is someone at the gate during school hours.

Dr. Fulton stated that he is continuously working to balance the budget.

Mrs. Livingston gave FSA data. The school grade was a C. There were 66 gains made across all departments. Formerly **ELA/ 41 %, Math 45%, Science 40%, Civics 62%

The School Improvement Plan will be created with the voice of the staff and parents and we want input from everyone.

Mrs. Livingston stated that in the future we want you to here from the classroom teachers and what learning looks and feel likes. The teacher leaders will be attending in the future or sending representatives to provide reports. SIP Goals for each department are a general 5% across the board. ELA=46%, Math 49%, Science 45%, civics 67%
