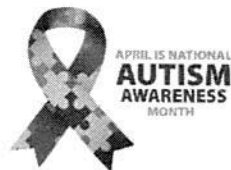

SAC Meeting

April 22, 2019

Meeting called to order at 6:15 pm by Co-Chair, Mr. Vinson Jones, Magnet Coordinator. Parents and staff were welcomed to our SAC meeting.

We reviewed minutes from our SAC meeting on March 18th. Motion to accept the minutes by Mrs. D. Jonson and seconded by Mrs. Pitter.

Mr. Jones expressed his appreciation to the teachers in attendance representing 3rd, 4th, 5th. He was ecstatic about "Pizza with the Principal."

Mr. Jones provided a review of SAC By-Laws, TITLE 1 Parental Involvement Compact

Mr. Jones stressed upcoming discussion at next SAC meeting:

SAC Committee, School Attendance.

Mr. Jones verified the DATA attained and solicited from members of expressing on the survey of SIP Attendance Plan Feedback from Stakeholders.

School Parent Compact-Mr. Jones explains that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve State's. Mr. Jones requests any changes we want to make. A section for the attendance is suggested.

Parent Family Engagement Plan-We are planning to have 2 STEM Museum Nights. One in the Fall and one in the Spring. What nights are better for SAC Meetings. We should get feedback from the community to find out. Our goal is 20 parents each meeting. Mr. Jones suggested an SEL parent night. To help increase the awareness of the mental health of the students. Yoga, meditation, counselors and district resources can be emphasized. A parent suggested we talk about the importance of firearm safety in the home. Ms. Pitter suggested that we do a survey at the **beginning** of the year (Open House) to find out what information the parents are interested in.

1. What are some obstacles that prevents families from maintaining a good attendance record?

Transportation, crisis at home, parent's work schedule, not having reliable adult to bring students and not living in boundary.

2. Suggestions as to how we can motivate parents to maintain a good attendance record:
Monthly Attendance Recognition for Perfect Attendance, display Students picture on Bulletin board or Grade Level bulletin boards, provide incentives such as pencils, erasers or certificates. We can Do more education on Attendance Policy, how early pick-up impacts students' attendance, Reassure our undocumented family members to diminish their fears,

When there are crisis family needs, we have 211 BEDS as a resource. We don't utilize our Social Security numbers, but each student has their ID #'s. During the Open House program include a segment on Attendance. Create an attendance Brochure/ contract. Every newsletter should have helpful tips, information encouraging parents. Provide a reward/ Gift card for motivating.
