- -Feb 21, Thursday is the next SAC meeting is very important. One building at a time. One classroom at a time will take 6 years, so one building at a time. When asked, classes will go where ever there is room. No, you do not have to take everything out of your classroom, but teachers may not be decorating for the next school year. October-December
- -Last week, we had district folks came out and facial recognition and audio capability cameras will be installed in the blind spots
- -There are a lot of academic programs going on at the school, and he is encouraging parents to support. We are in a room full of data. We are finding out that about 80% of K is coming in with nothing (lack of knowledge of alphabet and sounds)
- -PreK-2, students are learning how to read; 3-5, they are reading to learn.
- any help that parents can give is appreciated
- -school letter grades are determined by grades 4 and 5

-everyone is doing everything they are doing to help the students as Mr Alejo even has a group at 12:30 that he works with

Ms. Gonzalez's Notes:

- -Mrs. Gonzalez encouraged parents to come in for our ESOL Math Game Night. A flyer will go out on the Friday. The night is open to everyone in our school to bridge the gap between school, parents, and the community.
