## A+ monies

Discussed last year's process and options. Ms. Barba indicated that we were not given enough time to process the options. A discussion about a more equitable distribution ensued. Andie proposed 50% to the high school teachers and staff and-50% to all college and high school staff. The group liked the idea, but Susan proposed a 60/40 instead. Team unanimously agreed to the following proposal and Susan volunteered to email it to Lynn Goldman:

60% of the A+ funds to be equally distributed to all 2017-2018 high school full time faculty and staff. 40% of the A+ funds to be equally distributed to all 2017-2018 full time contracted Sheridan Tech College staff and high school faculty and staff.

## Rationale:

1) The 289 9th and 10th grade students earn the school grade and are ONLY in contact with high school staff.

2) With all of Sheridan campuses, all faculty and staff getting a piece of the 40% will be almost the same amount as last year. The 60% to the high school is rewarding those that did the job of earning the A.

3) High school staff works with students 4 times longer than college teachers.

college: 221 students, 180 days x 2.5 hours/day=450 hours x 2 years = 900 hours high school: 510 students, 180 days x 6 hours/day=1080 hours x 4 years = 4320
