January 22, 2019– 8:00 am

Welcome/ Role Call to Establish Quorum:

Mr. Duverneau welcomed all SAC members to our first SAC meeting for 2019 and wished everyone a Happy New Year.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Duverneau read the minutes and they were approved by Mr. Pierre and second by Mr. Lopez.

Highlighting Successes:

A slide show was shown highlighting our successes: Veterans Day (Lunch with our Veterans), Student of the month breakfast, Christmas Activity (staff working together in Unity), Christmas Panda Raffle (Selected students received a gift).

Principal Updates:

Mr. Gibson wished everyone a Happy New Year. Excited to continue to work with SAC members for the second half of (2018-2019) the school year.

- **BSA-Gr. 3-5 ELA (Reading & Writing) & Math: January 23, & 24, 2019:** Students are scheduled to take the BSA assessment this week. The BSA test is used to formulate FSA strategic strategies to allocate resources on what areas the teachers need to focus on to get the end results, which is an “A”. Mr. Gibson reiterated that support will be aligned based on BSA data.
- **3rd grade Tutoring:** 3rd grade tutoring has already started this month (January). Mr. Gibson stated teachers are volunteering their time after school, providing students the extra help they need to get them ready for the

FSA test. Tutoring has also started for some 2nd grade classes. A Teacher's evaluation is based on the student learning. The outcome of a Teacher's evaluation can be Satisfactory, Unsatisfactory, Effective or Highly Effective. Administration also receives a grade (Principal and Assistant Principal). Administration and teachers will continue to discuss/crunch data.

- **Annual Family Literacy Night:** Family Literacy Night is scheduled to take place on January 31, 2019. Mr. Gibson encouraged all SAC members/parents to come out and join Palmview in taking a trip around the world to South Central, Africa, and Europe etc. Also there will be poetry and storytelling time. Parents, students and the community will be able to learn strategies to help their child be successful with classroom instruction and learning. Flyers are scheduled to go home this week with each student. The class with the most participation will be recognized.
- **ESE Specialist:** Ms. Days is the new ESE Specialist. Ms. Walker retired after 35 years of service with the Broward County School Board. Ms. Walker received a good send off from her Palmview family. Palmview Wishes her Well and a Happy Life.

Accolades are given to our teachers for their patience, love and hope for our students that they serve here at Palmview.

School Improvements Plan: Mid-year reflection

Mr. Duverneau stated there are 4 questions in the School Improvement Plan that need to be answered by the administration, support staff and team Leaders. They will discuss and answer the 4 questions from 2018 FSA results and BSA data. Once the questions are answered, they will be submitted and uploaded in the School Improvement Plan (SIP). Mr. Duverneau projected and reviewed last year (2017-2018) questions and answers with the SAC committee. In Reading and Math we are looking for 70% of our students to be proficient. The school's goal is to be an "A" school.

Mr. Gibson stressed the importance of reading. Parents are to have their children read every day. Reading is fundamental. Also it is the foundation to math, science etc.
