1. **Call Meeting to Order** - Mrs. Weaver calls the meeting to order at 3:05 pm.

2. **School Improvement Plan (SIP) Updates by Principal and Departments**
 - Guidance- Eric Belliard – Scheduling process is complete. Currently the Dual Enrollment process is finishing up to accommodate the district changes. Students are still going on Naviance and looking on Virtual Counselor to verify their schedules and plan for future academics. Guidance is attempting to eliminate schedule changes for next year.
 - Reading/Writing – Anita Parsotan – English and reading teachers are working on curriculum aligned with next month's Reading FSA.
 - Math – Denise Miranda – Absent - Dr. Georgy. After school camps are being held on Tuesday and Thursday for EOC. AP courses are also holding review session after school and during super testing days. Push in and pull outs are being done in Algebra 1 and Geometry classrooms in preparation for their EOCs.
 - Science – Vamini Ramkissoon – Biology EOC is on May 16th. The dept. is on task to finish the curriculum and review for the EOC. Some teachers are volunteering their Saturdays to hold Biology review camps.
 - Principal Updates – Vivian Suarez – Chorus singers just received superior scores at states. Parents please complete the online parent survey. Track teams were very successful during last week's meets. The accountability funds are being used for the push ins and pull outs. NHS induction ceremony is tonight. The single point of entry entrance should be completed in May. We are still in the process of finding safer places within the classroom. Funds were donated and raised for stop the bleed kits. North area advisory meeting is tomorrow at Monarch High School.
