#### I. Welcome 5:20

#### II. Principal's Report 5:21

Dr. Lacasse thanks everyone for being at the SAC/SAF meeting and says that the school is running fine.

- A. Graduation will be May 31st in the morning. Each student will be allotted 6 tickets but is not allowed to sell unused tickets to their peers.
- B. Ms. Jones has sent out a temporary list of Dates to Remember for the next couple of months.
- C. Nova has hired a new family therapist who is doing great things for the school. The school used to have four to six Baker Acts per week. We have yet to have one since she joined us.
- D. Tomorrow (Friday, February 1) is Take Your Child to Work Day. The school is expecting to have low attendance.


