



## SAC Minutes 11/27/2018

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### Attendance:

### Call to Order:

A meeting of the Nova Blanche Forman School Advisory Council was held in the ESE Classroom on 11/27/2018. SAC Chair, Lisa Dalachinsky, called the meeting to order at 8:50 AM. Phyllis Gelman-Mash will record minutes for this meeting.

### Minutes:

Mrs. McCord motioned to approve the minutes of 10/23/2018. Mr. Frank seconded the approval. Further clarification was given on what RTI and PLC stands for as well as the make-up of the groups that were mentioned in the minutes.

### New Business:

1. School board is very behind in approving volunteers. At this time, it is up to the principal's discretion to approve volunteers.
2. School improvement plan is written based on the needs of the school and is waiting on approval from the state. Once approved, it can be found on Nova Blanche forman's website.
3. Every school has an Equity Liaison. Ms. Dalachinsky is the liaison for NBF. A plan has been created to insure that schools are covering the required topics: Hispanic Heritage, Black History, Holocaust, and Women's History. Activities are meant to bring awareness and acceptance of different cultures.

### Committee Reports:

School Advisory Committee: Mrs. McCord attended and reported:

- School website should be able to access teacher's website. They are working on having that happen.
- Broward County library provides live tutors for homework help from. 2:00 PM - 11:59 PM.
- School Board's policy on make-up work was discussed. Discussion pertained to middle and high school students more so than to elementary students. However, there is a policy in place for all students.
- ESE advisory meeting will be tomorrow – They will be discussing how to access student's IEP from home.

**SAF Meeting:** Updates were given about the Youth Mental Health training.

**Principal Update:** Mr. Schwartz was unable to attend, Ms. Dalachinsky reported:

- Title 1 parent nights are being planned and have to follow the Title 1 Parental Involvement Plan
- Data chats began on Monday, November 26<sup>th</sup>. Teachers meet with administrators and support staff to discuss the progress of each of their students
- Barnes and Noble night will be on Thursday, December 13th
- 20 Thanksgiving baskets went home with families in need of some extra assistance
- A holiday toy drive will be going on the first couple of weeks of December to benefit some of our needy families
