Call to Order:

A meeting of the Nova Blanche Forman School Advisory Council was held in the ESE Classroom on 10/23/2018. SAC Chair Lisa Dalachinsky called the meeting to order at 8:50 AM. Phyllis Gelman-Mash will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Ms. Batool motioned to approve the minutes of 9/25/2018. No changes were needed.

New Business:

1. The SAC by-laws were reviewed. They were approved by Coach Clarke and Ms. DeHart along with the rest of the members.
2. School Improvement plan was discussed. We will be working on scaling up the RTI process and improving our PLCs. After approval by the district and state, the SIP plan will be a public document for all to see. At that time, it will be posted on our website.

Principal Update:

1. Safety – We are in constant communication with the other zone schools. Nova zone is going to be doing a zone safety drill that will include all of the zone's school. The district is supporting two new apps for reporting suspicious activity and keeping parents abreast of any happenings.
2. We recently finished International Peace Week.
3. Sundae on a Monday will be coming up soon – it had to be postponed until another week.
4. It is red ribbon week and we are participating in daily activities to support the "Say No to Drugs" theme.
5. "Where in the World is Mr. Schwartz?" –Geography initiative. Based on clues that students are getting, they are guessing where in the world Mr. Schwartz is.
6. "We Care" Thanksgiving baskets are coming up soon. Students will be asked to bring in a food item for the "We Care" bags.
7. Book Character Parade will be taking place on Halloween. Students can dress in costume coordinating with a book character.

Open Agenda Items:

1. A Parent Night is being coordinated by Ms. Batool and Ms. James. It will be technology related.
2. Support staff will begin pulling 4th and 5th grade small groups in reading and math. This aligns with our SIP plan.
